Our mission focuses on the individualized needs of our youth to prepare them for the transition from group home living to reunification with their family or independent living. In a nurturing environment, we address the emotional, physical, educational and spiritual needs of our youth through mentoring, tutoring, educational programming, individual counseling, cultural enrichment, life skills training, problem solving techniques, goal setting, recreational therapy and community service activities.

# Our History and Overview

Butterflyz LLC was founded in 2009, with an emphasis on youth who have special needs. Our mission and vision is to provide housing to youth in out of home care with a focus on employability skills and vocational training. With our community partnerships Butterflyz LLC focuses on providing experiences to youth to ensure their exposure to different careers and or college through volunteer and job shadowing opportunities.

In 2009 the organization was formed by Larina Hightower and Baboonie Tatum. At the time Larina and Baboonie worked in the Milwaukee Public School system as special education teachers they both taught youth who were involved in the foster care system. While working with the youth involved in the foster care system, the youth shared their grievances regarding the group homes they currently lived in. After listening to the youth Baboonie and Larina decided to be change agents and focused on opening a group home that focused on youth leaving care. Larina and Baboonie wanted to ensure that youth were exposed to vocational and employability skills training prior to aging out of the system. Then in January of 2019 Butterflyz LLC expanded their program by opening an emergency assessment center (Building Youth Assessment Center), that would serve male and female youth in out of home care that required emergency placement. In 2021 Butterflyz LLC became an accredited agency through the Council on Accreditation. The accreditation process has allowed our agency to put systems and policies in place that helped not only improve our program but also helps us track the data. Throughout the data collection process it allow us to see our strengths and weakness in order to improve our services.

With the success of our group home, our shelter care and our comprehensive programming we decided to expand our services further. Butterflyz LLC's most recent expansion includes the implementation of a series of community outreach programs in the following areas:

- 1. Milwaukee King Center Partnership
- 2. Wellness Services
- 3. Educational Supportive Services
- 4. Advocacy Services
- 5. Youth and Family After-care Services



#### 2023 PROGRAM ENHANCEMENTS SHORT-TERM PLACEMENT SERVICES

Program enhancements were made to the approach of short-term placements. In doing this, we created a new pathway in our service delivery model specifically for short term care. Short-term care is defined as a youth needing a short residential stay for either assessment, stabilization, or shelter services. All youth on this track received elevated case management that involved weekly assessments, stabilization services, and a crisis intervention plan.

#### AFTER CARE PROGRAM

The Butterflyz After Care Program were enhanced, and the program now offers resources for parents or guardians, educational support, and enhanced crisis prevention services. These enhancements improved placement stability for youth in the home & school after departing out of home care.

#### MERGER TO ELECTRONIC DATABASE

Butterflyz LLC merged over to an electronic client database and tracking system. Through this merger process, we were able to build an agency specific site that is set to manage records while capturing, tracking, and reporting on specific data. In addition, the system now allows the agency to have longitudinal reporting and comparison of performance with outcomes over time.









# **OUR DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN**
